Apply for SNAP Benefits Today!

In response to the global pandemic the Maryland Department of Human Services will provide all <u>current</u> Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) recipients and <u>new eligible applicants</u> with the **maximum benefit** amount for April and May. **Income guidelines for eligibility still apply.**

- **Apply by phone:** Local Department of Social Services cannot take applications by phone. If you want to apply by phone or need assistance with applying, contact **Maryland Hunger Solutions (MHS)** at 866-821-5552 for assistance with a **new** SNAP application only. MHS does not have access to existing SNAP applications. Call M-F between 10AM- 6PM and leave your name and a phone number. MHS is experiencing a very high call volume.

- If you are approved, you will receive benefits for the entire month.
